BACKGROUND

Directives, and especially Chief Clerk’s Memorandums (CCM), often include as part of the text, specific amounts referring to the currently charged fees, etc. As time goes by some of those fees are changed, and sometimes even eliminated. In a recent review of old directives, we realized that there were quite a few of these fees interspersed throughout the directives. Rather than go back and reissue all of those directives and CCMs with new fees, I am directing that they be deemed amended as follows.

DIRECTIVE

_____Any Directive or Chief Clerk’s Memorandum which contains a fee is to be deemed amended to reflect the fee in use at the time that the directive or CCM is being cited.
