BACKGROUND:

At its height, the Coronavirus pandemic caused a near-total cessation of in-person operations in the New York City Civil Court. In response, the Court developed and implemented a number of measures to provide a continuity of justice services during the pandemic, specifically through virtual appearances and electronic document processing.

The Court will continue to develop and expand virtual services for the foreseeable future, however, as we move into Phase 4 of New York City's reopening, it is apparent there are still some matters that have not benefitted from these innovations. For this reason, a targeted and limited return to in-person operations is required in order for the Court to meet the increasing demand for services that are being placed upon it. One such area where a limited resumption of in-person operations has become necessary is the trial of pending Housing matters. Therefore, the Court will continue its program of incremental return to in-person trials of Housing matters in New York and Queens Counties on September 8, 2020, balancing operational needs with health and safety requirements.

ADVISORY:

In-person trials of pending Housing matters will resume in New York and Queens Counties on or about September 8, 2020.

The Supervising Judges will select cases for trial, prioritizing, for the time being, two-attorney matters that were placed on the trial calendar before March 16, 2020 and which cannot be resolved virtually. Members of the bar and litigants will receive scheduling notices for these trials.
