**Deadline!** Your *Answer* must be served on the Petitioner at least **2 days** before the court date. If you do not serve and file your *Answer* by the deadline the court may approve the Petitioner's requests without hearing your side. *CPLR 403*

5. If the Court decides that the Tribal Court judgment should be recognized, the Court will direct that the Tribal Court judgment should be entered into the court records as a judgment of the Supreme Court of the State of New York.
