Overview

The Unified Court System (UCS) has been committed to improving access to justice for Limited English Proficient (LEP) individuals so they may actively participate in their court matters. To meet this objective, the UCS provides court interpreters in all types of proceedings and administrative hearings in over 100 languages. This dashboard is in response to Legislation 2019 - A.754-A LEP which requires the Office of Court Administration to collect and maintain data on Limited English Proficiency in the courts.

The data does not include Language Lines and Town and Village court data.
