

SUBJECT: Compensation Rates - Small Claims Assessment Review (SCAR) Hearing Officers

** This supersedes the provisions of Budget Bulletin number 274, dated July 3, 1995.*


Administrative Order AO/327/00, as signed by Chief Administrative Judge Lippman on May 19, 2000 provides that **effective June 1, 2000**, SCAR Hearing Officers appointed pursuant to Title 1-A of Article 7 of the Real Property Tax Law and 22NYCRR 202.58 shall be compensated at the rate of \$75.00 for each hearing held, **to a maximum of \$300.00 per diem**, regardless of the number of hearings held in any single day.

**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE
CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE JUDGE OF THE COURTS**

Pursuant to the authority vested in me under Title 1-A of Article 7 of the Real Property Tax Law and section 202.58 of the Uniform Civil Rules for the Supreme Court and County Court (22 NYCRR 202.58), in relation to special proceedings for small claims tax assessment review, I hereby amend, effective June 1, 2000, all existing administrative orders appointing small claims tax assessment review (SCAR) hearing officers in and for the Supreme Court in the several judicial districts and counties of the state, to provide that such hearing officers shall continue to be compensated at the rate of \$75.00 for each hearing, in no event shall any such hearing officer be compensated more than \$300.00 for any one day of hearings.
