

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE
CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE JUDGE OF THE COURTS

Pursuant to the authority vested in me, and with the advice and consent of the Administrative Board of the Courts, I hereby amend, effective immediately, section 101.2 of the Rules of the Chief Administrator of the Courts (22 NYCRR §101.2), relating to the membership of the Advisory Committee on Judicial Ethics, to read as follows:

Section 101.2 Membership.

(a) The Chief Administrator of the Courts, in consultation with the Administrative Board of the Courts and with the approval of the Chief Judge of the State of New York, shall appoint members to the committee in such numbers as deemed necessary to effectively carry out its duties and shall designate ~~the chair~~ **two co-chairs**.

(b) Each member shall be an active or former judge or justice of the Unified Court System.

(c) The members and the ~~chair~~ **co-chairs** shall serve at the pleasure of the Chief Administrator, ~~and shall~~ **Co-chairs may serve renewable five-year terms without limitation; other members may serve** be appointed for ~~two~~ **two** terms of ~~up to five years, provided that no member first appointed on or after~~ **up to five years, provided that no member first appointed on or after** November 1, 2000 shall serve for more than one five-year term ~~each~~.
