

**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE
CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE JUDGE OF THE COURTS**

Pursuant to the authority vested in me, and with the advice and consent of the Administrative Board of the Courts, I hereby amend, effective June 21, 2004, sections 208.42(f)(1) and 208.42(d)(10)(ii) of the Uniform Rules for the New York City Civil Court, relating to venue for certain housing proceedings brought in that Court, to read as follows:

**§208.42 Proceedings Under Article 7 of the Real
Property Actions and Proceedings Law**

* * *

(f) (1) Commencing May 21, 2001, all summary proceedings for residential premises located in postal ZIP codes 10035 and 10037, and for the Taft Houses and the Jefferson Houses, except proceedings brought by or at the direction of the New York County District Attorney's office under Real Property Actions and Proceedings Law, sections 711 and 715, shall be noticed and filed in the Harlem courthouse.

§208.43 Rules of the Housing Part

* * *

(d) Summons

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(10) Venue

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(ii) An action or proceeding involving premises located in postal ZIP codes 10035 and 10037, and the Taft Houses and the Jefferson Houses, shall be noticed and filed in the Harlem courthouse.
