**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE

ORDER NO. 23 - 20

Pursuant to the authority vested in me as District Administrative Judge, and in accordance with the recent operational protocols issued by the Chief Administrative Judge for the trial courts of the Unified Court System, it is hereby

ORDERED that all temporary orders of protection issued in the Suffolk County Family Court that are due to expire on a date on which the matter may not be heard due to extraordinary circumstances, including a public health emergency, are extended under the same terms and conditions for 90 days, unless the order is terminated or modified by a judge or by a referee assigned to the case, and it is further

ORDERED that all remand/removal and placement orders issued in Suffolk County Family Court under Family Court Act Articles 3, 7, 8 and 10 that are due to expire on a date on which the matter may not be heard due to extraordinary circumstances, including a public health emergency, are extended under the same terms and conditions until the date the matter is re-calendared, unless the order is terminated by a judge or by a referee assigned to the case.
