**Persons who have traveled in any of these states or territories on or after the date it was added to the quarantine list<sup>2</sup> must self-quarantine for fourteen days, and shall not be permitted to enter a courthouse or other court facility during that period.**

<sup>2</sup> Persons who travel through a state on the watchlist for a limited duration (less than 24 hours), for reasons of a rest stop or layover, are not required to quarantine.
