Hon. Cecile Noel

Commissioner, NYC Mayor's Office to Combat Domestic Violence

Hon. Cecile Noel was appointed Commissioner of the Mayor's Office to Combat Domestic Violence (OCDV) in October 2015. OCDV was established by city charter in 2001, and is charged with coordinating the delivery of citywide domestic violence services, and formulating policies and programs relating to domestic violence services. The office also oversees the Family Justice Centers that operate in Brooklyn, Queens, the Bronx and Manhattan, serving over 2,700 clients a month.

Hon. Joan B. Lobis

The Women's History Month Distinguished Jurist Award Recipient

Hon. Joan B. Lobis has served as a Justice of the Supreme Court, First Judicial District, since 1991. She currently presides over a Medical Malpractice Part and has previously presided over a Matrimonial Part, a General I.A.S. Part, and has served as a Judge of the Civil Court of the City of New York and in the Housing Part.
