



The Children's Center at Nassau County Family Court

The Children's Center at Nassau County Family Court is a North Shore Child & Family Guidance Center program that provides short-term childcare to families who must appear in Family Court.

The Children's Center provides a safe, supervised and secure environment for children to play and interact with one another. The Children's Center provides a setting that makes it possible for children to have fun while their parents or guardian attends court. The Children's Center applies a program that meets current National Association for the Education of Young Children (NAEYC) standards for developmentally appropriate practices.

- Staff in the Children's Center at Nassau County Family Court are certified in CPR and First Aid.
- The Children's Center is located inside the west side module on the first floor in the Nassau County Family Court building.
- The Children's Center can accommodate approximately twelve children at one time. The Children's Center can accept children whose age ranges from infant through twelve years old.
- The Children's Center is open from 9:00AM through 5:00PM, on days when the Family Court is open, and closes for lunch between 1:00PM and 2:00PM. The Family Court follows the New York State schedule of official holidays.
