

Affirmation of Service: Motion to Waive Court Costs, Fees, and Expenses

Service Time Frames

Civil Practice Law and Rules section 2214(b) requires motion papers to be served a certain number of days before the court date depending upon:

- 1. what method is used to serve the papers
- 2. how far in advance you want the opposing party's answering papers to be served on you

Motion papers must be served at least eight (8) days before the court date, and then the opposing party must serve any answering papers at least two (2) days before the court date if the motion papers are served by:

- personal delivery to a party or a party's lawyer (see Section A)
- personal delivery to a lawyer's office (see Section C)
- personal delivery to a person of suitable age and discretion (see Section D)
- fax (facsimile) transmission and then mailing (see Section E)

However, if motion papers are served at least sixteen (16) days before the court date, the party making the motion can demand in writing that the opposing party must serve any cross-motions or answering papers at least seven (7) days before the court date, and then the party making the motion must serve any responding papers at least one (1) day before the court date.

Additional Time Required for Service by Regular Mail or an Overnight Delivery Service

If the motion papers are served by regular mail (see Section B) from *inside New York State*, add **five (5)** days to the service time frames above. For example:

- to serve the motion papers at least eight (8) days before the court date, mail the papers at least thirteen (13) days before the court date (8+5=13)
- to serve the motion papers at least sixteen (16) days before the court date, mail the papers at least twenty-one (21) days before the court date (16+5=21)

If the motion papers are served by regular mail (see Section B) from *outside New York State*, add **six (6)** days to the service time frames above. For example:

- to serve the motion papers at least eight (8) days before the court date, mail the papers at least fourteen (14) days before the court date (8+6=14)
- to serve the motion papers at least sixteen (16) days before the court date, mail the papers at least twenty-two (22) days before the court date (16+6=22)

If the motion papers are served by an overnight delivery service (see Section F), add **one (1) day** to the service time frames above. For example:

- to serve the motion papers at least eight (8) days before the court date, send the papers by overnight delivery at least nine (9) days before the court date (8+1=9)
- to serve the motion papers at least sixteen (16) days before the court date, send the papers by overnight delivery at least seventeen (17) days before the court date (16+1=17)

- If you served one or more people by personal delivery, complete Section A
- If you served one or more people by mail, complete Section B
- If you served a party's lawyer at their law office, complete Section C
- If you went to a party's home or their lawyer's home and gave the papers to a person of suitable age and discretion, complete **Section D**
- If you served one or more people by fax and mail, complete Section E
- If you served one or more people by overnight delivery, complete Section F

Note: If a party is represented by a lawyer, you must serve the lawyer, not the party.

REMINDER:

- When mailing motion papers from inside New York State, add five (5) days to the service time frame
- When mailing motion papers from *outside New York State*, add **six (6) days** to the service time frame

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Section D: Service by Delivery to a Person of Suitable Age and Discretion

REMINDER: If you go to the party's home or their lawyer's home and they are unavailable, you can leave the papers with a person of suitable age and discretion who is at home. You can only use this type of service if the person's home is located *inside New York State*.

 A person of suitable age and discretion means the person is old enough to understand the situation, responsible, and likely to give the papers to the respondent. This person does not have to be an adult but should not be a small child. For example, a responsible teenage babysitter may qualify; someone who appears drunk or mentally impaired may not. The judge ultimately decides if the person who received the papers is a person of "suitable age and discretion."

Note: You must first try to serve a lawyer at their office. You can only serve a lawyer at their home if you were unable to serve them at their office (see Section C).

Section E: Service by Facsimile (Fax) and Mail

REMINDER: Additional time for mailing is not required when you fax the papers first.
