### **SPEAKER'S BUREAU**

Guest speakers may include various professionals like court officers, attorneys, judges, and more.

#### **MOCK TRIALS**

Mock trials, facilitated by staff, allow students to enact court proceedings based on provided scenarios. They aid in teaching trial procedures and trial-related content for grades 6-12, with flexible durations and staff support.

#### CARFER DAY/CARFERS IN COURT

Our staff will attend events aimed at providing information on various careers in the court, promote current job openings, civil service exams, and provide an opportunity to speak with our district staff.

#### COURT TOURS

We offer a court tours program in New York State for students, citizens, and civic organizations. The program includes a courthouse tour, Q&A session, and viewing of a court proceeding to enhance understanding of court operations.

#### **COMMUNITY OUTREACH**

Local courts engage with the community through interactive sessions, classroom presentations, and partnerships to educate about court operations. They collaborate on recognizing heritage months, community events, and promoting access and equal justice programs.
