By letter dated April 23, 2019, David T. Meglino, Esq., counsel for plaintiff, requests that this action be assigned to the Commercial Division pursuant to Uniform Rule 202.70. No response to this letter application has been received.

Plaintiff commenced this action for breach of contract arising out of a multi-million-dollar construction project on January 30, 2019, by filing a summons and complaint. On April 15, 2019 defendant filed a motion to dismiss the complaint together with an RJI. Since the RJI was filed without a Commercial Division addendum, the case was assigned to a General Part (Hon. Louis Nock). Eight days later, plaintiff's counsel filed this letter application requesting assignment to the Commercial Division.

Upon review, it is clear that the action meets the standards for assignment of cases to the Commercial Division (*see*, Uniform Rule 202.70[a]). Accordingly, the request for assignment to the Commercial Division is granted. The General Clerk's office is directed to transfer this proceeding from IAS Part 38 (Nock, J) and randomly assign it to a Justice of the Commercial Division.
