ASSIGNMENT: The Special Projects Counsel works out of the Presiding Justice's Chambers and interacts with supervisors in all offices of the Appellate Division, Third Department; reviews reports concerning various aspects of the judicial arena; researches and analyzes complex legal and administrative issues; acts as a liaison for the Presiding Justice with administrative staff on items under con-sideration by the Administrative Board; may be asked to assist the Presiding Justice in preparing both written and oral remarks she may be asked to give, and communicates with members of the Judiciary and individuals employed in the Unified Court System.
