Upon the annexed Attorney Affirmation of Monica A. Duffy, Esq., Chief Attorney, dated May 22, 2024, together with the exhibits annexed thereto, the Affirmation of Samuel H. Younger, dated May 23, 2024, and upon all the papers and proceedings heretofore and herein, it is

ORDERED that respondents show cause before the Appellate Division, Third Judicial Department, Justice Building, Empire State Plaza, Albany, New York, on the return date of Monday, September 9, 2024, at 10:00 A.M. why an order should not be granted suspending respondents from the practice of law due to uncontroverted evidence of their professional misconduct pursuant to the Rules for Attorney Disciplinary Matters (22 NYCRR) §1240.9(a)(5), and Rules of the Appellate Division, Third Judicial Department (22 NYCRR) §806.9, and for such other further and different relief as this Court deems just and proper; and it is further

**ORDERED** that sufficient cause having been shown, in accordance with Judiciary Law §90(6), service of this Order to Show Cause and the papers upon which it is granted by: (1) publication on this Court's website at <a href="https://www.courts.state.ny.us/ad3">www.courts.state.ny.us/ad3</a>, commencing on or before June

4, 2024, and continuing thereafter until the return date of this motion; (2) email to respondents at

any and all email addresses on file with the New York State Office of Court Administration.

Attorney Services-Registration ("OCA") for those respondents having an email address on file

with OCA, on or before June 4, 2024; and (3) first-class mail to any and all mailing addresses on

file with OCA for those respondents not having an email address on file with OCA, on or before

June 4, 2024, shall be deemed good and sufficient service; and it is further

**ORDERED** that, pursuant to Practice Rules of the Appellate Division (22 NYCRR)

§1250.4(a)(5) and Rules of the Appellate Division, Third Judicial Department (22 NYCRR)

§806.9(c) and (e): (1) this Order to Show Cause will be submitted on the papers; (2) papers in

opposition to this Order to Show Cause shall be filed on or before 4:00 P.M. on the Friday before

the return date of the order, with the Office of the Legal Profession, NYS Supreme Court,

Appellate Division, Third Judicial Department, P.O. Box 7288, Capitol Station, Albany, New

York, 12224, together with proof of service of a copy of such papers upon petitioner; (3) papers in

opposition filed with the Clerk shall include satisfactory proof of compliance with the attorney

registration requirements of Judiciary Law §468-a and Rules of the Chief Administrator of the

Courts (22 NYCRR) §118.1; and (4) applications may not be argued unless otherwise specified by

the Presiding Justice.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE, that in the event of default in filing such papers in opposition,

the Court may proceed to impose discipline or take other appropriate action.
