Godosky, Esq., of the firm Godosky & Gentile, P.C., representing the plaintiffs in the action captioned above, moves this Panel for an Order pursuant to Section 202.69 of the Uniform Rules for the Trial Courts, coordinating the action with eight (8) other State Supreme Court cases presently pending in various judicial districts, all of which allege claims for personal injury stemming from the ingestion of a combination of the prescription drugs Bextra, Celebrex and/or Vioxx. Movants withdraw the motion by a letter dated May 26, 2006. The Hon. Helen E. Freedman, Presiding Justice of the Panel, grants the request to withdraw the motion in her own behalf and with the authorization and in behalf of all other members of the Panel. The "Pfizer Defendants" request that the Panel rule on Coordination, in a letter dated June 05, 2006. This request is made notwithstanding the withdrawal of the motion by the "Beattie Plaintiffs." That request is denied.

ORDERED, that the motion for Coordination of Related Matters brought by the plaintiffs in the above captioned matter is allowed to be withdrawn without prejudice to the "Pfizer Defendants" making their own motion for Coordination of the related matters.


