

Courthouse banner lauds jurors on postage stamp

The official banner for the first stamp honoring jurors is in the Onondaga County Courthouse.

The stamp is currently available at post offices nationwide. Both the stamp and banner were unveiled in September in New York City, said Sid Oglesby, Onondaga County commissioner of jurors.

The stamp followed a letter-writing campaign in 2006, he said.

Oglesby asked the post office and the office of court administration for the banner to celebrate Jury Appreciation Day Nov. 12 and was allowed to keep it.
