The Hon. Craig J Doran, Administrative Judge for the 7th Judicial District, has announced that the Courts located in the Hall of Justice, 99 Exchange Blvd, Rochester, NY will be suspended between 9 A.M. and 2 P.M. on Wednesday, September 10th, 2014.

Judge Doran stated " Out of respect for those that wish to attend the funeral of Rochester Police Officer Daryl Pierson, and in consideration of the impact that this will have on courthouse operations, I am directing that all court proceedings at the Hall of Justice be suspended on Wednesday, September 10, 2014 from the opening of business until 2:00 P.M."

We anticipate that the Rochester City Court Arraignment Part and the Monroe County Family Domestic Violence Court will remain available to entertain emergency applications.
