

THE PRE-ARGUMENT STATEMENT

APPELLATE DIVISION—FIRST DEPARTMENT

(Annexed to Notice of Appeal — Serve one on each adverse party — file 2 with Court of Original Instance with proof of service)

Amended February 1984, §600.17, subdivision (a) dictates that the Pre-Argument Statement take the following form; “to which shall be attached a copy of the opinion, if any, or if applicable a short form order which contains a memorandum:

Title of the Action.

Full names of original parties and any change in the parties.

Name, address and telephone number of Counsel for Appellant or Petitioner.

Name, address and telephone number of Counsel for Respondent.

Court and county, or administrative body, from which appeal is taken.

State whether appeal is from an Order or a Final Judgment, and the date of entry thereof.

State whether there is any additional appeal pending in the same action, the date of entry of the order or judgment, and attach a copy of the notice of appeal and the pre-argument statement.

State whether there is any related action or proceeding now pending in any court of this or any other jurisdiction, and if so, the status of any such case.

State the nature and object of the cause of action or special proceeding (contract, personal services, sale of goods, etc.; tort-personal injury, automobile, sidewalk accident, etc.; equity, specific performance, injunction, etc.).

State as briefly as possible the result reached in the court of administrative body below.

State as briefly as possible the grounds for seeking reversal, annulment or modification.”
