## APPELLATE DIVISION, SECOND JUDICIAL DEPARTMENT ATTORNEYS FOR CHILDREN

## **COMPENSATION RATE**

The Attorneys for Children Program is responsible for compensating attorneys representing children and for paying reasonable disbursements incurred in the representation of their clients. Attorneys for Children representation in both trial and appellate court proceedings are compensated at the following rate:

Effective **February 2, 2022**, (For Kings, Queens and Richmond Counties) \$158 per hour.

Effective **April 1, 2023**, (For Nassau, Suffolk, Westchester, Dutchess, Putnam, Orange and Rockland Counties \$158 per hour.

Prior to the above listed dates, the hourly rate was \$75 per hour.

## **STATUTORY MAXIMUM**

effective **April 1, 2023,** the statutory maximum is \$10,000 per case. Prior to that date the statutory cap was \$4,400. Claims for compensation in excess of the statutory maximum require an affirmation of "extraordinary circumstances" to be submitted.
