PRESS RELEASE

Effective October 1, 2016, the Appellate Division, Fourth Department is repealing in its entirety 22 NYCRR part 1022 governing certain conduct of attorneys and procedures for attorney disciplinary matters. The Court is enacting 22 NYCRR part 1015 governing certain conduct of attorneys and 22 NYCRR part 1020 governing procedures for attorney disciplinary matters in the Fourth Judicial Department.

The rule changes are being made in conjunction with the effective date of 22 NYCRR part 1240, which contains rules governing attorney disciplinary matters in all Departments of the Appellate Division.
