Section 393 of Chapter 55 of the Laws of 1992 inserted a new Article 87 into the CPLR. CPLR § 8701, effective May 10, 1992 [and expiring April 1, 1994], provides that of each punitive damages award to a private party in a civil action, upon expiration of the time to appeal or the exhaustion of available appeals the State is entitled to a 20% share of such award, and that the judgment shall order payment accordingly.

In accordance with § 8702 the Clerk of the Court is required to send a copy of any such judgment within twenty (20) days of its issuance or filing (entry) to the Attorney General.
