Effective October 1, 2006 the New York City Health Code is amended pursuant to §27-5056.18 of the Administrative Code of the City of New York and §558(b) and (c) of the New York City Charter which authorizes the Board of Health to amend the Health Code.

To increase the effectiveness of the New York City Childhood Lead Poisoning Prevention Act of 2003, Local Law 1 of 2004 amended the Housing Maintenance Code and other provisions of the Administrative code with respect to addressing lead hazards in units in multiple dwellings in which a child of "applicable age" resides. Local Law 1 of 2004 included a provision defining a child of "applicable age" and also authorizes the Board of Health to amend such definition.

Effective October 1, 2006, the "applicable age" is defined as under <u>six</u> years of age, please see attached Notice of Adoption of Amendments to Section 173.14 of the New York City Health Code.
