Judge Mejias-Glover is the current Secretary of the Board of Latina Moms Connect, Inc. She became involved with Latina Moms of Long Island shortly after its inception and holds the organization and its members very close to her heart.

Judge Mejias-Glover is a Judge of the New York State Court of Claims, and previously served as Nassau County Family Court Judge. She was the first person of Latinx descent elected to any countywide judgeship in Nassau County.

Judge Mejias-Glover has been active in her local community and church as a mentor and leader her whole adult life. She is passionate about helping young members of the Latinx community, especially young women, understand and appreciate their full potential. She has worked with various organizations to teach students and parents about the value and necessity of higher learning and education.

Judge Mejias-Glover is a Past President of the Long Island Hispanic Bar Association (LIHBA), and created the Legal Information Program, which provides free legal information and support to the community.

Judge Mejias-Glover is a Past President of the Nassau County Women's Bar Association, and has served as Chairwoman of the Board of Herstory Writers Workshop, Inc.

In 2017, she became the first Latinx elected to the Board of Directors of the Nassau County Bar Association (NCBA). During her tenure, she founded the Diversity and Inclusion Committee and served with honor as the first Chair of the Committee.

Judge Mejias-Glover graduated from the Waldorf School of Garden City, *magna cum laude* from Wellesley College, and later received her Juris Doctorate from Columbia Law School.

Judge Mejias-Glover, is a First Generation American, whose Mother immigrated from Ecuador and Father was from Cuba She resides in Nassau County with her son, David, and husband, Dorian R. Glover, Esq.
