Position Title: Judicial Intern to Judge, Supreme Court, New York County – Commercial Division

Rising second or third-year law students, LLM students, and recent law school graduates interested in pursuing a career in commercial law, litigation, and seeking to develop their legal research and writing abilities are encouraged to consider a judicial internship in the Commercial Division. Judicial internships offer students and recent graduates invaluable insight into the judicial process and inner workings of judicial chambers, and the development of skills that are highly transferrable to private or public practice. Judicial interns will have the opportunity to observe all aspects of the judicial process including court proceedings, case management, legal research and writing, and exposure to the New York State court system.

Judicial interns will be tasked with, among other things: (1) preparing legal memoranda; (2) participating in and observing conferences, hearings, and trials; (3) drafting decisions and orders; and (4) generally assisting chambers in its daily operations.

This position is assigned to Hon. Anar Rathod Patel, Supreme Court, New York County – Commercial Division. Chambers accepts two judicial interns during each fall, spring, and summer of the year. Summer interns are expected to work full-time, five days per week, in person, and commit to a minimum of six continuous weeks.
