
ESTABLISHMENT OF A PLANNING UNIT FOR PURPOSES OF PREPARATION AND IMPLEMENTATION OF A LOCAL SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN

By the power vested in me as Mayor of the City of New York, it is hereby ordered:

Section 1. Planning Unit Authorized. In accordance with 6 New York Codes, Rules and Regulations Subpart 360-15, the City of New York is hereby authorized to be a planning unit for purposes of preparing and implementing a local solid waste management plan.

Section 2. Signature Authorized. The Deputy Mayor for Policy and Physical Development, whose office is established pursuant to Executive Order No. 73, dated April 30, 1984 is hereby authorized to sign an application to secure grant funds, submitted pursuant to 6 New York Codes, Rules and Regulations Subpart 360-15, and to sign any other documents as may be necessary to secure such funds.

Section 3. Effective Date. This order shall take effect immediately.

Report

Report pursuant to Sections 25-318 of the Administrative Code of the City of New York with respect to Docket No. 89-0528 a proposal for rehabilitation and restoration of the granite face and portions of the steel structural frame, limited cleaning of the masonry, waterproofing which includes repointing and recaulking, and restoration of the "Civic Fame" statue on top of the tower of the Manhattan Municipal Building (LP-0079), in accordance with Local Law 10. The proposal includes the installation of scaffolding during the period of rehabilitation.
