**DEPUTY MAYORS**

- i. Execute and deliver, in the name and on behalf of the Mayor, a certificate approving any borrowing of funds or pledge of assets or revenues by the New York City Health and Hospitals Corporation which would require the approval of the Mayor pursuant to the "Memorandum of Agreement Between New York City Health and Hospitals Corporation and The City of New York Relating to Operating Expenditures By the Corporation", dated July 1, 1970.
- j. Execute and deliver, in the name and on behalf of the City, Official Statements of the City relating to the issuance of the City's obligations.
- k. Represent the Mayor, when so directed by the Mayor, on any board, committee, commission or corporation of which the Mayor is a member.
- l. Perform any function, power or duty of the Mayor in relation to the execution of contracts, franchises, revocable consents, deeds and satisfactions.
- m. Perform such other duties as the Mayor may direct.

Section 7: Executive Order No. 73, dated April 30, 1984, is hereby revoked.  
 Section 8: This Order shall take effect immediately.

**MAYOR'S COMMITTEE ON THE JUDICIARY**

By the power vested in me as Mayor of the City of New York, it is hereby ordered:

Section 1. **Prior Order Amended.** Executive Order Number 10 (1978), as amended, is hereby further amended by adding a new section 9 to read as follows:

§9 **Corporation Counsel.** The Corporation Counsel shall maintain liaison with and review the activities of the Committee, and shall advise the Mayor and the Committee regarding measures which may enhance the ability of the Committee to consider the best qualified candidates for judicial nomination.

Section 2 **Effective Date.** This order shall take effect immediately.
