WHEREAS, the Court previously issued an order, pursuant to CPL 190.15 (1), that certain grand jurors currently sitting in four grand jury panels will continue to sit as a single grand jury panel up to and until a new grand jury is impaneled in the County of Suffolk, and

WHEREAS, for the reasons stated in the oral application made by Assistant District Attorney Rafael Pearl to this Court on March 20, 2020, the Court finds, pursuant to CPL 190.20 (6), that good cause exists to transfer an appropriate number of grand jurors from their current grand juries to this single remaining panel, it is hereby

ORDERED that an appropriate number of grand jurors should be transferred from the panels on which they are currently sitting to a single panel, and any grand juror so transferred is deemed to have been sworn as a member of the panel to which he or she is transferred.

This constitutes the decision and order of the Court.
